To make a long story short, the wife was healed instantly of the tumor, the husband was healed of a serious hernia, both children were healed of minor sicknesses and the whole family, plus some aunts, uncles, cousins and friends were all gloriously saved that night in a meeting that lasted well past midnight.

I can tell that story with confidence today because one year has passed and not only has the family stayed firm in the Lord, but they have won more to the Lord, testified all over that area and twice a month they

They are already holding Bible Studies and meetings in their homes and we will have "home churches" in Villahermosa and Teapa in the next few weeks with about 20-30 new believers in each.

It's amazing what God will do if we listen and obey Him!

Bro. Roberto obeyed the voice of the Lord and they traveled 3 hours each way to pray for what they thought was one lady and look at the result that obedience brought.

We will be taking the next 3 weeks off to finish work at our house to get ready for the move to North Texas. We really covet your prayers in this matter.

The Lord has laid many things on our hearts the last few weeks and we will be looking for a home in the Fort Worth area with extra rooms or an outside building we can convert to an office or a study to run the ministry from.

We have unbelievable amounts of study notes and sermons from Dad including dozens of audio tapes that we will be making available.

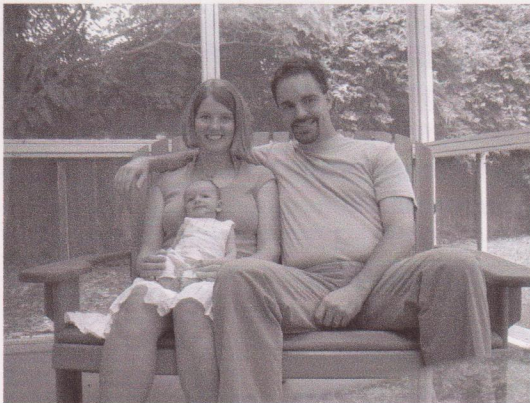

Alicia, Dustin and Isabel Grace

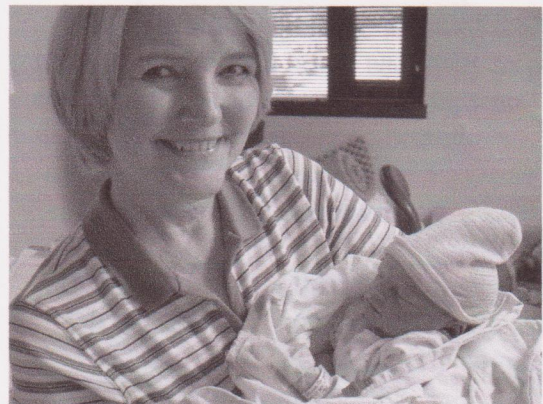
Isabel Grace Parker was born May 28, 2005 in Grapevine, Texas to Dustin and Alicia Parker.
